

## Town of Port Wing Recycling Center Policy

RECYCLING CENTER:  
Port Wing & Orienta Residents Only

Our "Recycling Center" always has attendant Brett Bodeen on duty when open, ready to answer any questions you might have. If you have something you would like to dispose of and are not sure if we can take it, check with the attendant before bringing it to the Center.

Anything that cannot be recycled should be placed in the plastic bags with the "Town of Port Wing" stamped on them. The bags can be purchased at the Center or at Johnson's Store at a cost of \$2.00 each.

Aluminum Cans, Bi-Metal (Tin) & Steel Cans with labels removed, glass containers with lids and rings removed, corrugated paper and flattened dry cardboard, newspapers, magazines, catalogs, and office paper can all be recycled at no cost to you. Plastic jugs and jars with the symbols 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 & 7 can be recycled. We can take most appliances but they must be 100% intact; our hauler will not take "parts" of appliances. We are working on a program so we can take metal also, so watch for signs on that.

We do not accept containers used for motor oil, antifreeze and similar products. These containers should be drained and recapped and put into the garbage bags. We cannot take any yard waste. We also cannot take Lead Acid Batteries, Waste Oil, Waste Tires, Rugs, Mattresses, or Furniture; these must be taken to an area business that sells these items. We cannot take any hazardous waste products such as paint, stains, poisons, pesticides, acids, household cleaners, chemicals, solvents, waste motor oil, fluorescent light bulbs, oil filters or computer components. Watch for hazardous waste collections by Bayfield County.
